

# SAINT GEORGE CATHOLIC CHURCH

April 27, 2025 — Sunday of Divine Mercy (Second Sunday of Easter)



**TODAY'S READINGS:** The Church does what Christ Himself did. The Church is the Body of Christ. As such, she continues Christ's work of healing, forgiving, reconciling, sanctifying and teaching His truth. As the Body of Christ, we, the Church, must always show the peace and love of Christ in our lives.

**First Reading: Acts 5: 12-16** - At the last Supper, Jesus said that He was sending His apostles forth just as His Father had sent Him. The Church is to do exactly what Jesus Christ Himself had done. Today's first reading tells of great signs which are worked in the Church because of the abiding presence of the Holy Spirit.

**Second Reading: Revelation 1: 9-11a, 12- 13, 17-19** - The Book of Revelation is the most misunderstood book in the entire Bible. It is not a collection of strange predictions for our times. It is a proclamation that Christ will triumph over all evils in this world. His triumph has begun even now in His resurrection; it will be completed when He comes again in glory.

**Gospel: John 20: 19-31** - The story of the gospel is the conversion of doubting Thomas; this is one of the greatest "proofs" of Jesus' resurrection. But the gospel also proclaims that the Church is to do what Christ had done. The Lord empowers His apostles to forgive sins; He gives them His Holy Spirit.

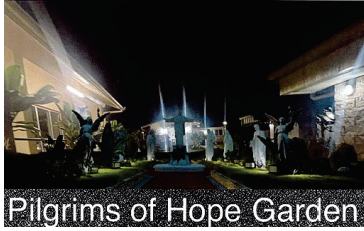

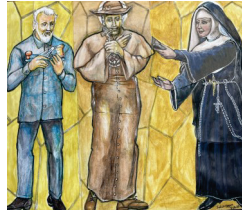
