**1st Reading: Wisdom 18: 6-9** - The Old Testament book of Wisdom was written during a time when God's people in Alexandria, Egypt, were distracted by the entertainments and pleasures of life. Wisdom reminds the people that God delivered them out of slavery in Egypt and made them a pilgrim people. God's very own.

Even when we do not understand the events of our lives, we must be a people of absolute fidelity to God, with joyful confidence that He will be faithful to us.
