Uniquely embraced by the majestic Koolau and rolling seas, we strive to be a welcoming parish and commit ourselves to serve the people of God through outreach, unity and renewal.

TODAY'S READINGS:

Jesus told us that whatever we do to the least of His brothers and sisters, we do to Him. We are responsible for recognizing our neighbor in need. If we fail to see the needs of others, we fail to see Christ. Let us pray that we shall never be complacent, but that we shall always care for Christ in our neighbor.

First Reading: Amos 6: 1a, 4-7 - Israel, in the Eighth Century before Christ, was materialistic and pleasure-seeking at the expense of the poor. The prophet Amos cried out against the indifference of the rich and powerful. He calls on them to see the plight of the poor and the dispossessed.

Second Reading: 1 Timothy 6: 11-16 - When the Lord comes again in glory, He will be the just judge Who rights all wrongs and corrects all abuses. Christians, St. Paul tells us, just live in constant expectation of the Lord's Coming. Such an expectation should prompt us to have a zeal for everything that is good.

Gospel: Luke 16: 19-31 - Today's gospel is the parable of the Rich Man and Lazarus. Jesus warns us that we must always have a practical care for our brothers and sisters in need. He also tells us that we have had the constant teaching of the prophets as well as the resurrection of the Christ to show us the true way of our life in God.

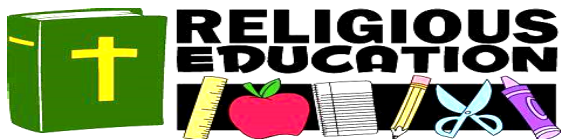
